

MR. JIMENEZ. (Continuing)... individual resolution but this is operational, so a lot of that goes through the En Banc but is not actually the subject of a resolution.

THE CHAIRPERSON. Can you give us copies of other similar directives that did not have En Banc approval?

MR. JIMENEZ. No, the absence of the resolution does not necessarily speak of the absence of approval...

THE CHAIRPERSON. Yeah, that's right.

MR. JIMENEZ. ... a lot of these matters are taken up in En Banc and are given to the executive director for operationalization.

THE CHAIRPERSON. Or is it possible also that the guy comes up with the memorandum sends it out and then you get validation... ratification afterwards?

REP. GOLEZ. My next question, Mr. Chairman.

THE CHAIRPERSON. Yes.

REP. GOLEZ. What if, even without a failure, the DOST would produce a duplicate copy using, let's say, they tell you that they have a problem and then you e-mail the program and then they configure a blank CF card to make it a duplicate card, what can be done with that? Can they... can it be used separately in order to transmit returns...

MR. FLORES. Yeah, it's a card that will work to read the ballots of an specific precinct.

THE CHAIRPERSON. That all it can do it just reads.

MR. FLORES. Yeah, and produce results.

REP. GOLEZ. And can it be used in order to instruct the PCOS machine to transmit several times?

MR. FLORES. Yeah, yeah, but he has to read the ballots first. With no ballots...

REP. GOLEZ. It will read the ballots and if it will be... can it be used to transmit several times?

MR. FLORES. Yeah, yeah.

REP. GOLEZ. The result of a... and the

MR. FLORES. ... if you put that card in a PCOS and it reads the ballots that are specific to that precinct, you produce results.

THE CHAIRPERSON. And... Mr. Flores, this is what you mean, thank you very much, Congressman Golez. This is what you meant that if you change the card then the machine would read again a scanned ballot.

MR. FLORES. You would have to repeat the ballots, yeah, you have to repeat the ballots.

THE CHAIRPERSON. So you could repeated it again.

MR. FLORES. Yeah.

THE CHAIRPERSON. Because you changed the card.

MR. FLORES. Yeah.

REP. CHONG. Mr. Chair, one final request.

THE CHAIRPERSON. Okay, okay.

REP. CHONG. One final request.

THE CHAIRPERSON. Maybe tomorrow na?

REP. CHONG. Because they have to finish

THE CHAIRPERSON. Wait, wait, wait Congressman...

REP. FLORES. If no other...

REP. GOLEZ. But it will be read as a message coming from the same source?

MR. FLORES. If there was indeed another machines that transmitted...

REP. GOLEZ. Because it is an identical CF card.

MR. FLORES. Yeah, correct like we showed yesterday.

REP. GOLEZ. That's the point, Mr. Chairman.

What they will produce is an identical CF card and the server will read it like it's coming from the same PCOS...

MR. FLORES. From the same PCOS.

REP. GOLEZ. ... the same card.

MR. FLORES. Aha.

REP. GOLEZ. Just like a duplicate SIM card, Mr. Chairman. I think many of us have duplicate SIM cards just in case of a failure.

THE CHAIRPERSON. But the thing it could... it would read scanned ballots again in which... this is just purely theoretical in which, for example, I had removed several ballots that favored my enemy.

MR. FLORES. That's a different thing which is something you can do on manual as well.

THE CHAIRPERSON. Yes. Of course, the manual is much, much more versatile.

So, can we end... ends tomorrow?

REP. CHONG. Special request for tomorrow, sir...

THE CHAIRPERSON. For tomorrow, special request.

REP. CHONG. ... to provide... for the COMELEC to provide us a list of those areas which may have availed of this contingent measure.

THE CHAIRPERSON. Okay, a list of those areas that availed of this contingency measure.

Thank you very much. This meeting is suspended.
